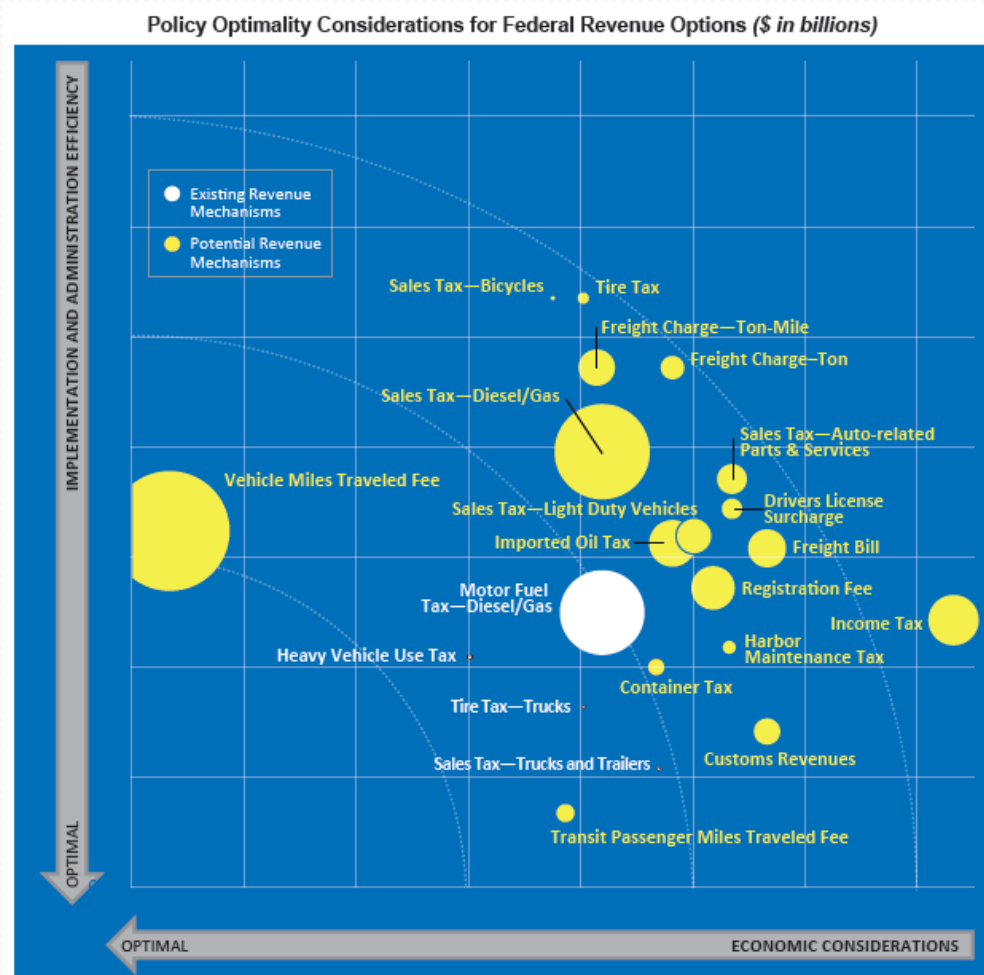

# New Stewardship & Oversight Agreement

- SCDOT is the first state transportation department since enactment of MAP-21 to receive approval of its Stewardship & Oversight agreement from FHWA.
- The Stewardship & Oversight Agreement documents the roles and responsibilities of the FHWA's South Carolina Division Office and the SCDOT concerning project approvals and oversight responsibilities.
- This Agreement will facilitate coordination between SCDOT and FHWA to further enhance effective delivery of the Federal-aid Highway Program in South Carolina.

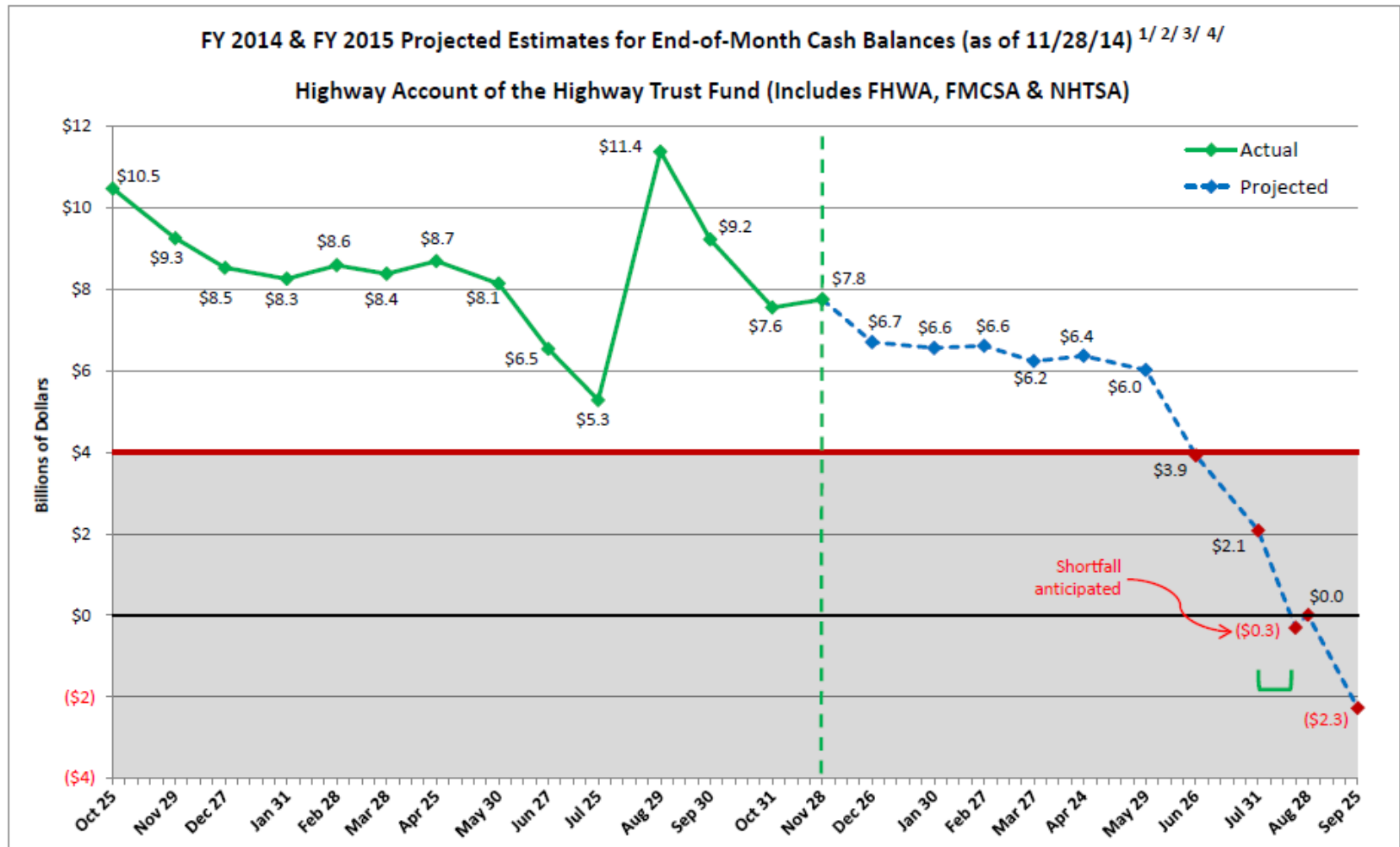
# Talking points

# Transportation Funding

- On July 31, 2014 Congress extended surface transportation funding through May 2015. (MAP-21 extension)
- Federal funding bills once sustained our transportation system for up to six years, but over the past five years, Congress has passed 27 short-term measures.
- The unpredictability about when, or if, funding will come has caused states to delay or cancel projects altogether.
- The result has been an enormous infrastructure deficit – a nationwide backlog of repairing and rebuilding.
- We cannot continue funding our transportation with measures that are short-term and short of the funding we need.



# Actions Needed in 2015

- A new Transportation Authorization Bill or further extension of MAP-21 which expires on May 31, 2015.
- Identification of a sustainable revenue source for national highway funding
- Infrastructure investment at a level which reflects our commitment to maintain the best transportation system in the world.
